COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

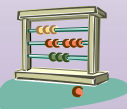

**MATHEMATICS**

Count reliably with numbers to 20.

Understand and give 1 more than/less than.

Relate numerals to amounts. Name 2d and 3d shapes and begin to describe them. Use everyday language related to time. *We will learn and demonstrate our mathematical knowledge through practical experiences indoors and outdoors.*
