COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Listening and Attention:

Listen to others in one to one situations and small groups.
Listen to and enjoy stories, building our recall of events and characters in the stories.

Understanding

Develop our understanding of objects and their uses.
Follow and respond to simple instructions.

Speaking

Begin to use more complex sentences to link our thoughts (e.g. those using 'and' and 'because').

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

People and Communities:

Look at ourselves and the people around us and the super things we all do.

The World:

Talk about how things happen and the way they work.

Technology:

Operate simple equipment.

MATHEMATICS

Number:

Compare amounts and understand amounts are needed.
Say numbers 1-10 and beyond.
Read numbers 1 – 10 and beyond.
Count each object in a set.



Shape, Space and Measures:

Become interested in shape and space by using shapes in our play and positional language.

LITERACY

Reading:

Listen to and join in with a range of different stories and rhymes.



Writing:

Use and experiment with a wide selection of different tools to make marks with.
Sometimes give meaning to the marks we make as we draw and paint.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Movement and Handling:

Move freely in a variety of ways such as running, slithering, shuffling, rolling, crawling, skipping and hopping.

Health and Self-care:

Express our needs to and adult.



PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Relationships:

Develop our friendships and build up relationships with new friends and adults.



Self Confidence:

Encourage children to be confident to speak to other children and adults.
Encourage children to be confident to try new things.

Feelings and Behaviour:

Develop our understanding of our own feelings.

How you can help:

Please label **all** items of clothing including wellies and shoes.
Things can go missing and this helps us to identify and return your child's belongings.

Please provide spare clothes for your child :- a change of pants, top and trousers/ skirt would be useful as accidents can happen or your child might get wet whilst playing with water.
