Be confident in our Early Years setting and manage a range of feelings.

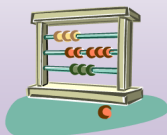
MATHEMATICS:

Recognise and recite numbers. Add groups and objects to find 'how many'.

Solve problems with numbers and groups of objects.

Notice shapes and patterns in the environment.

Explore weight, measure time and estimating.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD:

Explore objects, plants and animals in the environment and talk about features, patterns and changes.

Be aware of similarities and differences.

Talk about events in our own lives.

Use a range of technology equipment and know its purpose.

Complete programs on a computer.

An overview of your child's learning journey this term - Summer 2017

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT:

Develop our gross and fine motor movements by using jugs to pour, scissors for cutting and handling pencils and mark marks effectively for writing.

Explore different ways to move using our bodies while demonstrating coordination and awareness of space.

Children will have PE and movement in the School Hall on Mondays and Thursdays.

Lessons will teach basic skills for Dance, Gymnastic and Games skills. We will be taking part in Sports Day.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:
