Accessing reading books from home

We are so excited to share with you a new way for your child to read to at home which is in line with what they would be reading at school. Our expectation is that your child reads for at least ten minutes every day from the book level they have been given by their class teacher/s. This is for all children, those accessing learning at school and at home.

To access the **free** online books please go to:

1. www.oxfordowl.co.uk
2. Log in using your child's class details (see below) and click on the 'e-Books' icon which will lead you to the Oxford Owl eBook library and Read Write Inc. eBook library.
3. Access your child's levelled books through the e-library sections (you will receive a text from school confirming your child's book level)
