

An overview of your child's learning journey this term - Autumn 2019**PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

Build new relationships with adults and peers and develop our relationships with others so that we can feel confident and ask for help when needed.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Jump, climb and land safely using climbing and balancing equipment. We will be exploring different ways of travelling.

Manipulate small objects, tools and fastenings and developing our hand control so that we can begin to be independent in our self help skills.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Listen in a range of different experiences and situations., developing good listening skills. When speaking we will learn the meaning of new words and explore using these when speaking and playing with peers and adults.

MATHEMATICS

Take part in number rhymes developing awareness of how number can be represented in different ways and begin to recognise groups of numbers within 5. We will explore patterns within numbers. We will be noticing shapes and patterns around us as well as learning to sequence our day.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

Explore colours and what happens to these when they are mixed. We will use paint and other materials to purposefully represent our own ideas. We will look at examples of art work and recreate our own, focusing on self portraits.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

Take notice of our immediate environment, and talk about what we see hear and feel in the natural world. We will be exploring seasonal changes and exploring scientific concepts such as melting and freezing.

We will be noticing changes and differences between ourselves and others now and in the past.

Computing

Develop skills to use the different range of technology available in our environment, including keyboard and mouse skills and using simple paint programs to create work.

We will be learning to recognise that computer can be a source of information.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Water bottles - Please provide a named/labelled water bottle. This will be returned home at the end of each day.

Wellies - Please could you provide wellies and spare clothes (including socks and pants) for your child.

Class 1 - Book Bags and Home Learning. Reception children are provided with a book bag. This is to be returned to school daily. Home learning tasks and reading will be gradually introduced to support and reinforce learning.

Reading - Children will receive a library book weekly. Please encourage your children to enjoy sharing and reading their library and reading books.

LITERACY

Notice print in our environment, developing awareness of code knowledge (letter sounds of the alphabet).

We will be exploring mark making in a range of situations and learning to giving meaning to our marks. We will be learning to recognise, represent and write our own names and other simple words.

Share stories daily, make comments about what we read and answer and ask questions about what we are reading.
